This introductory course will survey Canadian history from the earliest recorded times to the Confederation of British North America. Themes examined will include: great explorations by land and sea; native-newcomer relations; New France from colonization to conquest; the development of the British North American colonies; and the changing impact of British, French, and American power in the region to be known as Canada. After a brief introduction to academic history, the political, social, and economic aspects of the formative years of Canadian history will be explored.
